




Santa Clara County School Enrollment is Declining





- K-12 Enrollment has fallen 8% over the 6 years from 2014-15 to 2020-21, a loss of more than 23,000 children
- Countywide enrollment has declined every year since 2015, and 24 of the county's 26 public school districts serving elementary students have seen declines
- Elementary schools, serving younger children, are seeing larger declines



The majority of public school districts in Santa Clara County are affected

- Of the County's 26 school districts, 25 have experienced enrollment declines over the last 7 years.
- This represents a loss of 24,993 elementary students
- Steep declines predate the pandemic: the final pre-pandemic enrollment census showed a 12% countywide decline, with almost all districts affected



South Bay School Enrollment is Forecast for Major Declines


- Elementary school enrollment will continue to decline 13% over the next decade












